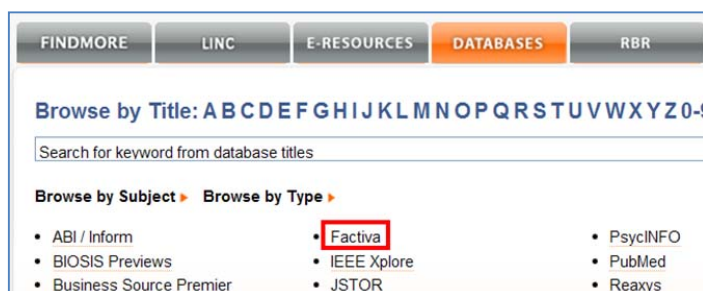

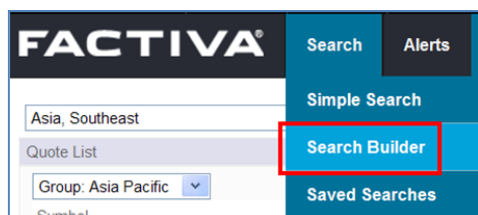

Search for newspaper articles from Singapore newspapers e.g. Straits Time to find latest Singapore information on selected topics.

1. Go to NUS Libraries (<http://www.lib.nus.edu.sg>).
2. Click on Databases Tab.
3. Click on Factiva.



4. At the Factiva search screen, mouse over Search and click on Search Builder.




5. At the search box, enter your keywords.

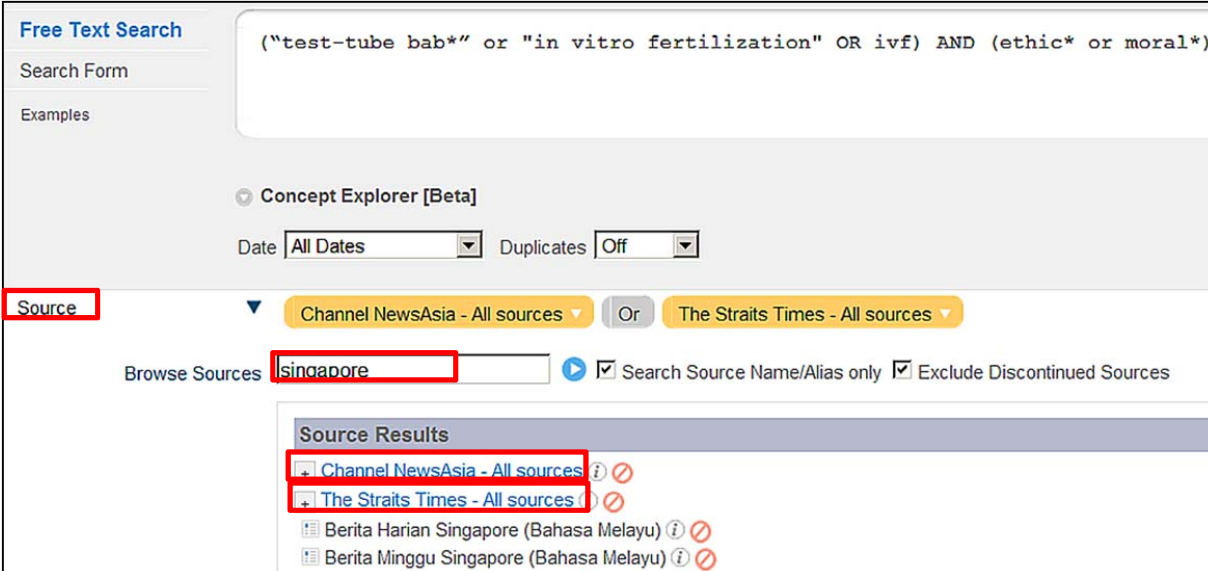

6. To limit search to Singapore news sources:
 - a. Click on Source.
 - b. In Browse Sources, search for Singapore. Click on Search icon. 
 - c. Select news sources that you want to search in.
