

Search for articles from ProQuest databases

1. Go to NUS Libraries (<http://www.lib.nus.edu.sg>).
2. Click on **Databases** Tab.
3. Enter **ProQuest** in the search box.

4. At the Databases page, select one of the first two listed **ProQuest** options:

5. At the ProQuest search screen, select **Advanced Search**. Uncheck the default **Full text** option.

6. Enter your **search terms** in the Advanced Search boxes:
 ("test tube bab*" or "in vitro fertilization" OR ivf) AND (ethic* or moral* OR relig*)

7. From the results screen, **view abstract** or **full text** as shown below:

8. As shown above, you may **refine** your search further by **Source type, Subject, Date**, etc.

9. You can **output** selected records from the     menu.

10. Click  to **format** selected records in your preferred style e.g. APA:
