




FindMore vs. LINC

FINDMORE

- Searches LINC & more
- Covers books, eBooks, journal articles, newspaper articles, online thesis & more
- Used for broad searching

LINC

- Good for known item search
- Covers books, DVDs, music scores
- <u>Cannot</u> be used to search for journal or newspaper articles





Where to start searching?

Search options	When to use
FindMore	 Good starting point for a quick search to see what is available Need only a few full text articles
Subject databases e.g. PsycINFO	 Doing a literature review Looking for more focused results Need a specific filter/limit for searching e.g. peer-reviewed journals, research methodology





What are Boolean Operators?



AND (narrows search)

Finds records with both terms



OR (broadens search)

Finds records with either or both terms

Note: shaded areas indicate retrieval

Creating Search Statement 1. Identify Keywords

Topic: Has Milgram's experiment been replicated and published in recent times?

Keyword 1	Keyword 2	Keyword 3

Creating Search Statement 2. List Synonyms & Related Words

- Think about other terms such as
 - synonyms or related terms
 - alternative spellings e.g. US vs British

Keyword 1	Keyword 2	Keyword 3
Milgram	experiment	replication
	study	replicated

Tips: Look up synonyms in:

- ✓ built-in thesaurus e.g. PsycINFO, subject headings, key concepts, descriptors
- ✓ Books, dictionary, handbook or encyclopedia

Creating Search Statement

3. Broaden a keyword search with



Truncate using asterisk * to pick up plurals and variants e.g. stud* = study, studies, studied, studious ...

Creating Search Statement 4a. Combine keywords with AND/OR

- Use AND to combine keywords
- Use OR to connect synonyms, related terms

Keyword		Keyword	Keyword
Milgram	AND	experiment* AND OR stud*	replicat*


Create Search Statement 4b. Use parentheses for synonyms

 Use parentheses (...) to group words/phrases that you want processed first

Search statement:

Milgram AND (experiment* OR stud*) AND replicat*


PsycINFO (OvidSP)

- Updated monthly



PsycINFO: Advanced Search




Why Advanced Search?

- Searches keyword occurring in 7 fields (title, abstract, heading word, table of contents, key concepts, original title, tests & measures)
- Supports Boolean operators, truncation, etc.
- Gives you better control of your search



PsycINFO: LIMITS

- Used to refine (narrow) search results
- Numerous pre-defined limits:
 - Age Group
 - Publication type
 - Test and measures
 - Research methodology




EndNote: Cite While You Write

Tips - Refining Results

Type of results	Ways to refine	
Too many	 Narrow search by Adding another keyword using Boolean AND Applying Limits (e.g. Peer-reviewed, publication type, etc.) Try searching keyword in the Title field 	
Too few	 Look at the references of a 'good' article to find other related articles Reduce the no. of keywords 	
None	 Check spellings & Boolean logic Use a different database that is likely to include information on your topic




